***Should the student decide to continue at CCC and complete the 30 credit Certificate they can earn the Automotive Service Excellence G1-Auto Maintenance and Light Repair

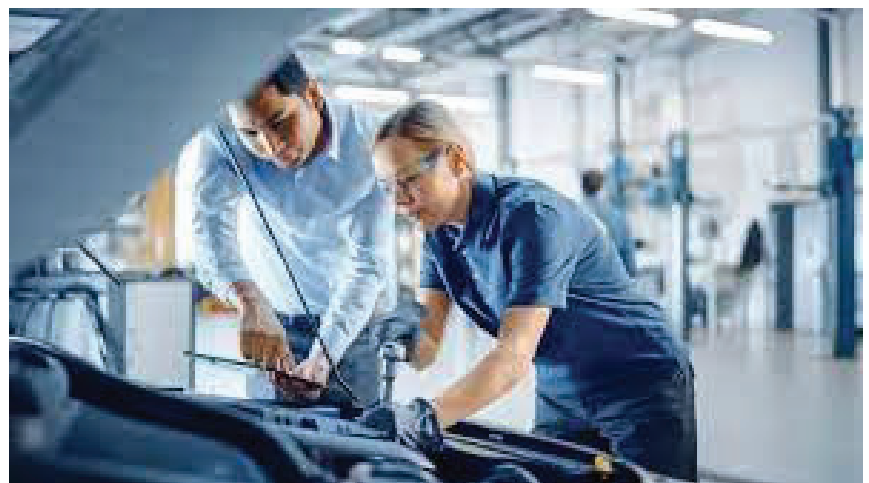
